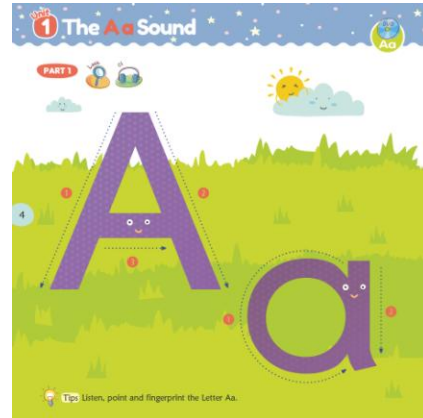
The Aa Sound- Part 1

Teaching Goal

- To be able to recognize and identify the upper and lower case of **Aa**.
- To be able to remember the letter **Aa** and the sound it makes.
- To be able to trace the letter with correct strokes.

Materials

- ✓ ACD Track 01
- ✓ DVD **Aa**
- ✓ LivePen
- ✓ A soft ball
- ✓ Ink pad, crayons or markers
- ✓ Flashcard and photocopies of the letter **Aa**



Time

1.5 hrs (80 minute lesson + 10 minute break time)

Warm-up/ Circle Time (15 Minutes)

1. ABC Song.
2. Greeting: **Q: “How are you feeling?” / “How are you (doing)?”**
A: “I feel ____.” / “I’m ____.”
3. Pass the ball around and ask each child how they're feeling today.



Teaching Tips

- ☆ *Make sure each child gets a turn answering and give encouragements and reward them with “**Good job!**” or “**Great work!**”*

Introduction of the Alphabet (15 Minutes)

1. Introduce the letter **Aa** and the sound to the kids.
2. Say the letter slowly and ask the kids to repeat as a group or individually.
3. Ask the children to follow you and trace the letter with their fingers up in the air.



*Play **ACD Track 01** during the teaching.*



For IRS Pen ONLY

Variation of the game

*Ask the children to stand up and trace the letter **Aa** with their bottoms, elbows, feet or other parts of their body. (Children enjoy games that involve a lot of movements).*

Activity Time (25 Minutes)

Game: I Spy

1. Make some photocopies of the upper and lower case of the letter **Aa** and place them in different places in the classroom.
2. Ask the children to find them and call out the name and the sound of the letter.

Game: Musical Aa

1. Place copies of **Aa** on the floor and play songs and ask the children to walk or dance around the classroom.
2. When the music stops, the children need to find **Aa** and stand or sit on it.

Student's Book- Let's do it! (15 Minutes)

1. Open **Student's Book to Unit 1 Part 1** and ask the children to trace the letter **Aa** with their fingers.
2. Ask the children to say the name and sound of the letter.
3. Use ink pad, crayons or markers and fingerprint or trace the letter with correct strokes.
4. Reward the children encouragements: stars/ stickers/ hugs/ hi-fives.



Teaching Tips

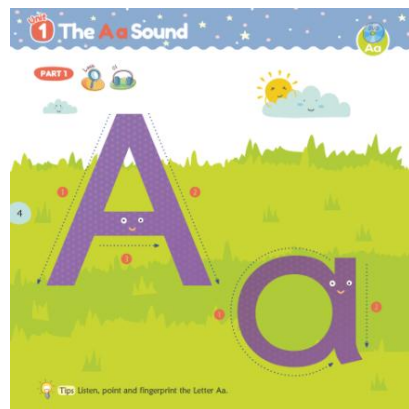
- ☆ *Listen, point and fingerprint the letter **Aa**.*

Wrap-up/ Review (10 Minutes)

1. Show the children the flashcard of **Aa** and review as a class.
2. Saying Goodbye to the letter and place it on the Alphabet wall.



*Play DVD **Aa** during the review.*
