

Unit 5

The Dd Sound- Part 4

Teaching Goal

- To be able to recognize and identify upper and lower case of **Ee**.
- To be able to remember the letter **Ee** and the sound it makes.
- To be able to trace the letter with correct strokes.
- To remember the vocabulary words that begin with **Ee** (**egg/ elephant/ envelope**).
- To be able to follow the words with their fingers and say the chant.

Materials

- ✓ DVD **Ee**
- ✓ LivePen
- ✓ Flashcards of **Ee**
- ✓ Plastic eggs and chopsticks
- ✓ An envelope
- ✓ Playdough, Crayons or markers

Time

1.5 hrs (80 minute lesson + 10 minute break time)

Warm-up/ Circle Time (15 Minutes)

Q: "What's your favorite color?"

A: "My favorite color is _____."

1. Review the different colors with your class and make sure the kids are familiar with them.

Game: I Spy

1. Tell the children that you will say: "**I spy with my little eyes something that is red.**"
2. Then they need to run to touch any object in the classroom that is red.
3. Continue playing until you have reviewed all the colors.



Remind the children of some **safety rules** before playing: **No running, pushing...etc.**

Review Lesson (15 Minutes)

1. Review the letter **Ee** and the sound with the children.
2. Review the new vocabulary words: **egg, elephant envelope** to make sure the children are familiar with the words and pronunciation.



3. Clap and say the chant together as a class.

Teaching Tips

- ☆ *Divide the class in teams and compete with their peers during the review can increase the children's interests in learning. Keep on reminding them **not to be arrogant** and **encourage** some slow-learners to **keep on trying and not to give-up!***

Activity Time (25 Minutes)

Game: Egg relay

1. Review the vocabulary words with your class and make sure they are familiar with the words that begin with **Ee**.
2. Prepare some plastic eggs and write egg, elephant and envelope on each one.
3. Tell the children that you're going to call out a word and they need to find that egg and use chopsticks to bring that egg to the other side of the classroom.
4. Continue playing until everyone has a turn.



Remind the children be careful with using the chopsticks.

Game: What's in the envelope?

1. Review the new vocabulary words with your class and make sure everyone's familiar with the new words.
2. Prepare some pictures or write the new vocabulary words on paper.
3. Tell the children that you're going to put one inside the envelope and they need to guess what it is.
4. The team or player that gets it right gets a point.

Student's Book- Let's do it! (15 Minutes)

1. Open **Student's book to Unit 5 Part 4** and ask the children to shape the letter **Ee** with playdough and color the pictures.




Teaching Tips

- ☆ *Shape the letter **Ee** with playdough and color the pictures.*



Wrap-up/ Review (10 Minutes)

1. Practice vocabulary words and chant as a group or individually.
2. Reward children with stickers, hugs, high-fives...etc.
