

Unit 7

The Gg Sound- Part 4

Teaching Goal

- To be able to recognize and identify upper and lower case of **Gg**.
- To be able to remember the letter **Gg** and the sound it makes.
- To be able to trace the letter with correct strokes.
- To remember the vocabulary words that begin with **Gg** (**girl/ goat/ goose**).
- To be able to follow the words with their fingers and say the chant.

Materials

- ✓ DVD **Gg**
- ✓ LivePen
- ✓ Flashcards of **Gg**
- ✓ Number flashcards
- ✓ A die
- ✓ Some shaving cream and a tray
- ✓ Crayons or markers



Time

1.5 hrs (80 minute lesson + 10 minute break time)

Warm-up/ Circle Time (15 Minutes)

Q: “How old are you?”

A: “I am ____ years old.”

1. Review the sentence pattern and numbers with your class.

Game: Roll the die

1. Tell the children that they need to roll the die and answer the question “**How old are you?**” according to the number they see on the die.
2. You can also review numbers and teach new ones by using two dice.

Review Lesson (15 Minutes)

1. Review the letter **Gg** and the sound with the children.
2. Review the new vocabulary words: **girl, goat, goose** to make sure the children are familiar with the words and pronunciation.
3. Clap and say the chant together as a class.



Teaching Tips

- ☆ Divide the class in teams and compete with their peers during the review can increase the children's interests in learning.



Do have to remind the children **not to be arrogant** and **encourage** some slow-learners to **keep on trying and not to give-up!**

Activity Time (25 Minutes)

Shaving cream drawings

1. Review the vocabulary words with your class and make sure they are familiar with the words that begin with **Gg**.
2. Prepare some shaving cream and a tray.
3. Tell the kids that you're going to play Pictionary, but instead of drawing the picture on the board, you are going to draw your picture in shaving cream.
4. Invite children to come up and draw in shaving cream for the class to guess.



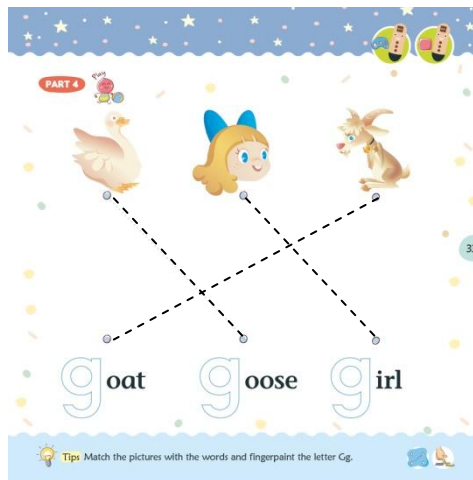
Do have to **REMIND** the kids to be careful with the shaving cream and **NOT TO TOUCH the eyes or put it into the mouth**. Prepare wet towel for them to wipe and clean their hands after the game.

Game: Match the number with the picture

1. Review the new vocabulary words with your class and make sure everyone's familiar with the new words.
2. Prepare a die for the kids to roll and tell them that each number represents a new word they learned.
3. You can write the code on the board.
4. When the player rolls the die, they need to call out the word that it represents.
5. The fastest one gets a point.

Student's Book- Let's do it! (15 Minutes)

1. Open **Student's book to Unit 7 Part 4** and ask the children to match the pictures with the words and finger paint or use crayons or markers to color the letter **Gg**.



Teaching Tips



Match the pictures with the word and finger paint or color the letter **Gg**.

Wrap-up/ Review (10 Minutes)

1. Practice vocabulary words and chant as a group or individually.
2. Reward children with stickers, hugs, high-fives...etc.
