

Unit 9

The li Sound- Part 2

Teaching Goal

- To be able to recognize and identify the upper and lower case of **li**.
- To be able to remember the letter **li** and the sound it makes.
- To remember the vocabulary words that begin with **li** (**ink/ igloo/ Indian**).

Materials

- ✓ ACD Track 30
- ✓ DVD **li**
- ✓ LivePen
- ✓ Flashcards or photocopies of the vocabulary words that begin with **li**
- ✓ The favorite toys of the children
- ✓ Crayons or markers



Time

1.5 hrs (80 minute lesson + 10 minute break time)

Warm-up/ Circle Time (15 Minutes)

Q: “Do you want to play together?”

A: “Sure.” / “Sorry, not right now.”

1. Ask children to show their favorite toys in the class to everyone.
2. Give the children a chance to do “Show and Tell”.
3. Talk about their toys and then find different partners and practice the sentence pattern, i.e. **“What color is the toy?”; “Does your toy have a name?”; “What’s the name of the toy?”**...etc.



Teaching Tips

- ☆ Show great level of energy and **give encouragements when the children participate in the activity**. Also do **give a bit more time for some shy kids** and **no need to push or force them** if they don’t feel ready yet.
- ☆ If some kids forget to bring their toy, you may ask them **to draw on a piece of paper** or may give them an **interview about their toys** if they are willing to do so in the class.

Introduction of the new vocabulary words (15 Minutes)


1. Review the letter **li** and the sound with the children to help them refresh their memory.
2. Take turns tracing the letter with their fingers. (Can be done as a group, pairs or individually.)

3. Introduce the new vocabulary words: **ink, igloo, Indian.**

 Play **ACD Track 30** during the teaching.



For IRS Pen ONLY

Teaching Tips

- ☆ Act out the vocabulary words before showing them the picture. This keeps the children interested in what you're going to show them.

Activity Time (15 Minutes)

Sing Along: 10 Little Indians

1. Teach the children the “**10 Little Indians**” song.
2. Start with one child and start singing “**One little, two little, three little Indians....**”
3. When you get to the 10th Indian. Ask that child to stand up and name one of the new vocabulary words that start with **li**.

10 Little Indian Song

One little, two little, three little Indians,
Four little, five little, six little Indians,
Seven little, eight little, nine little Indians,
Ten little Indian is a boy/girl.



Give encouragements for participation.

Student's Book- Let's do it! (15 Minutes)

1. Open **Student's book to Unit 9 Part 2** and ask the children to listen to the CD.
2. Point to the letter **li** and say the name of each vocabulary word.
3. Reward them with “**Great job!**” or “**Wonderful!**”...etc.



Teaching Tips

- ☆ Listen to the **li** sound and say the name of each picture.



Activity Book-Let's do it! (10 Minutes)

1. Open **Activity Book to Page 21** and ask the children to circle the pictures that match the letters.
2. Say the vocabulary words with the teacher.
3. Color letter **li** on the page.



Teaching Tips

- ☆ Match the pictures with the words and color letter **li**. It is a good idea to **demonstrate how to do it beforehand**, so the children have a clear understanding of the instructions.

Wrap-up/ Review (10 Minutes)

1. Show the children pictures of **ink, igloo, Indian**.
2. Practice as a group or individually.
3. Saying Goodbye to the new vocabulary words.



Play **DVD li** during the review.
