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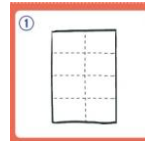
Little Story Book (Fold-Cut-Open-Squeeze-Crease-Done!)

There is also a cut-out of **My Little Phonic Book** at the very back of the book. Please feel free to take some time to follow the instructions and teach the students how to make it in class. The book would be a very useful and helpful tool for the kids to review the chants and also for them to be able to point out the words they have learned from this book.

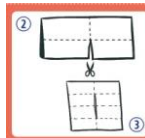


Instructions

1. Cut out the parts of **My Little Phonic Book** from the page and fold up the page into 8 even sized squares by the lines.

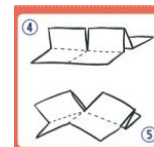


2. Unfold the page and once again fold the page horizontally in half, then cut the middle line of the page to the center with scissors and make sure not to cut through the page.



3. Unfold the page again and make sure the page has 8 even square-sized folding lines and there is an open cut in the center of the page.

4. Take the page and hold the two sides with both hands and push them towards each other.



5. Lay the book-to-be on the table and flatten all the pages, then your **My Little Phonic Book** would be done!
