PO: No, you didn't, sir. I don't think anyone could drive too fast in a **plastic**<sup>2</sup> kid's car.



Man: A plastic kid's car? That's not my car! No wonder it was so slow.

## COUNTABLE / UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

Countable nouns are nouns that we can count. We can use articles (*a, an, the*), *some, any, a few*, or *many* with countable nouns. However, we cannot count uncountable nouns, and we usually treat them as singular.

Countable Nouns	Uncountable Nouns
I eat <b>an</b> apple every day.	I eat rice every day.
I like apples.	I like rice.
She buys <b>some</b> apples every week.	She has <b>some</b> money.
Did you buy <b>any</b> bananas?	Did you buy <b>any</b> soda?
I don't have <b>many</b> friends.	I don't have <b>much</b> time.
I have <b>a few</b> friends.	We have <b>a little</b> time.
I feel lonely because I have <b>few</b> friends in the new class.	There is <b>little</b> time left.
He has <b>a lot of</b> children.	He bought <b>a lot of</b> meat.
She has <b>lots of</b> shirts.	She drinks <b>lots of</b> milk.
They have <b>plenty of</b> online games.	I drink <b>plenty of</b> water.
