






A linking verb connects a subject with a subject complement. The most common linking verb is the verb **to be**. Others are **verbs of sensation** (feel, look, smell, sound, taste) and **verbs of existence** (appear, become, get, grow, keep, remain, seem, turn).

PAST CONTINUOUS

S. + **was / were** + **V-ing**

WHEN TO USE?

We use the past continuous to talk about an action happening at a specific time in the past.

Last night at 8 p.m., I was watching TV.


Yesterday at this time, May was sitting at her desk at work.

Note

In the simple past, a specific time is used to show when an action began or finished.
In the past continuous, a specific time only interrupts the action.

- Last night at 8 p.m., I **watched** TV. → I started watching TV at 8 p.m.
- Last night at 8 p.m., I **was watching** TV. → I started earlier, and at 8 p.m., I was still watching TV.

We can also use the past continuous to talk about a shorter action (**past simple**) happening during a longer action (**past continuous**).



I was taking a shower when he called.

While we were having a barbecue, it started to rain.



Netting a Better Deal

Booking¹ a hotel room online is convenient, but, before you key in your credit card number, take a closer look. If the deal seems too good to be true,
5 it probably is. Make sure to read the following advice before you pay.

Location²

If the online booking service states that the hotel has a "great view" or is "five
10 minutes from the beach," use an online map to check. The "great view" could be of the **parking lot**³, and the hotel might be five minutes from the beach by taxi!

Transportation

15 Will the hotel send a minibus to the airport to pick you up? Is the transportation complimentary? You don't want to spend the first day of your holiday stuck at the airport. Call or e-mail the
20 booking service to get more information.

Traveler's Reviews⁴

Learn from the experience of others. There are many **forums**⁵ online where travelers post their reviews about hotels,
25 beaches, and services. The hotel you want might look good in pictures, but if other travelers are complaining about it, you might want to think again.

Deposits⁶ and Fees

30 Some hotels ask for a **nonrefundable**⁷ room deposit before they can **confirm**⁸ your booking, but others might return your deposit as long as you cancel at least a day or two before the booked date. Read
35 the **fine print**⁹, or you could lose a lot of money!

Travel is fun, but it's a lot more enjoyable if you ask some questions before you go.


