

Robber: No need for thanks. The pleasure was mine. Good night and good luck.





VERBS + OBJECT COMPLEMENTS

An **object complement (O.C.)** is a present or past participle that provides more information for the object. It can help explain the situation of an object and its relationship to a verb.

Present participle phrases after the verb are from continuous sentences. The action or actions may or may not have finished.

Past participle phrases after the verb are from passive voice sentences. They are a result of a situation or the emphasis of a sentence and are completed actions.

find + participle

Present Participle	My mother finds me <u>sleeping on the couch every night</u> .
	Ellen will find the faucet <u>leaking all over the floor when she gets home</u> .
Past Participle	Desmond found his pie <u>eaten by his sister</u> .
	The mail carriers are finding the building <u>closed when they arrive</u> .





The last thing you need is insurance packages*

For many of us, nothing beats the thrill of traveling abroad and the rush you get when you first **set foot in**¹ an unfamiliar country. The strange smells, sights, and sounds make for a unique sensory experience, no matter which country you **land in**. Excitement **beckons**² around every corner. There are markets and museums to discover, and interesting people to meet. **The last thing you need is** for your trip to be **sidetracked**³ by a lost passport. Accidents like this can and do happen, so it makes sense to be prepared for them as best you can.

Before you travel, make photocopies of all your important documents, including your passport, **insurance policy**⁴, travel visa, and any other **relevant**⁵ personal information. Be sure to leave copies with your parents, **along with** your **itinerary**⁶. Give a set to your travel partner, and make one for yourself, too. This will make it easier for you and your **embassy**⁷ or **representative office**⁸ to replace the **originals**⁹ if they are lost or stolen.

It's a good idea to purchase travel and health insurance before you depart.

30 These days, many low-cost **insurance packages** are available for young travelers. And while you're at it, check for any health alerts in the country to which you are traveling and get all necessary **immunization**¹⁰ shots. **The prick of a needle** may hurt, but being sick in a foreign hospital is much worse!

Finally, prepare some money to use in case of **emergency**¹¹, and **keep it separate from** your spending money. Most people **opt**¹² for traveler's checks because they're safer. **Be on the lookout for**¹³ pickpockets. But if your wallet or purse is lost or stolen, you'll still be able to call a family member for help. Money can be **wired**¹⁴ to most places in the world.

Follow these tips and you are sure to have a wonderful vacation. Bon voyage!


