



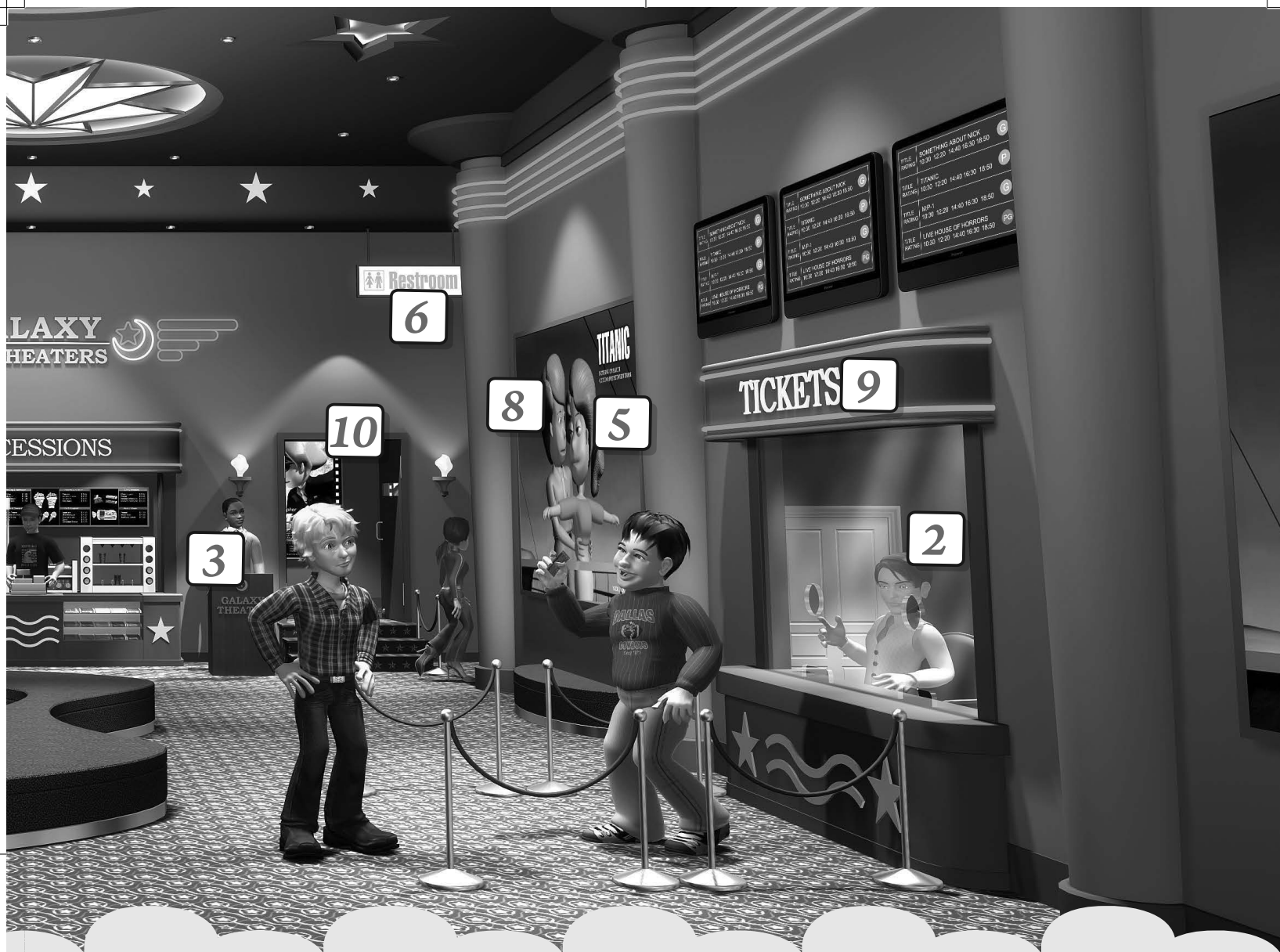

Jenny: Well, you two guys are enjoying it. I'll wait for you by the box office.

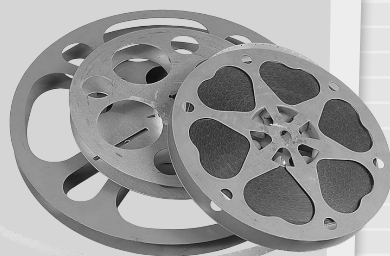
