* 在美國一度風行的一種看電影方式就是 drive-in theater。這種電影院在美國二次大戰後開始流行開來，因為那時候人們漸漸富裕，擁有自己的車也越來越多，所以人們會開著車到這種露天的 drive-in theater，在自己的車上輕鬆的看著電影、吃東西、聊天。這種戲院在 1950 年代的美國各地區非常多，但後來由於家庭電視的普及以及電影院的素質提升，使得這種看電影方式漸漸沒落，目前全美國僅剩幾百家還在營業。雖然在這種露天的戲院看戲必須忍受不良的天氣狀況，但也仍是一種特別的體驗。

Going to a Hair Salon

Hairstylist: What can I do for you today?

Leslie: I would like **to get a shampoo** and a **haircut**, but I can't decide what kind of hairstyle I should get.

Hairstylist: Would you prefer **short hair**, or do you want it long enough for a **ponytail**?

Leslie: Well, I don't want it too short, like a **crew cut**; just short enough so that I don't have to worry about **styling** it every morning.

Hairstylist: I could **layer your hair** to give it more volume and shape. Or, better yet, you might consider a **perm**.

Leslie: I'll pass on the **perm** for now. I just **dyed my hair** a few weeks ago. I like the idea of getting my hair layered, so let's do that. Would it be possible to get a **manicure** at the same time?

Hairstylist: Sorry, but our manicurist is with another client now. Would you mind waiting about half an hour?

Leslie: No, I don't mind at all. That would be fine.

Hairstyles

How do you describe someone's hair? You might say that it's long or short; straight or curly. But if you want to be more specific, there are several other ways to describe the style, shape and look of hair.

A woman has bangs if the hair at the front of the head is cut short, just above her eyebrows. If she has long hair, she could tie it in a ponytail, wear it in a bun, or braid it into pigtails. Some people prefer to part their hair in the center, while others prefer to part it on the side.



A man who has very short hair, about 3/4 of an inch long around the head, has a buzz cut, a style that is typical for army soldiers. The sixties rock group the Beatles became famous for their mop-top hairstyles, while in the seventies, the mohawk became a fashionable hairstyle among young people who liked punk music.
