The Tablet Age

Smartphones^{*} have been **trendy**¹ for many years, but now **worldwide**² attention is focused on tablets. While you can **surf**³ the Net on smartphones, many **consumers**⁴ have trouble with their small screens. Tablets have become more **popular**⁵ because you can easily read their larger screens. Tablets have changed the way we use the Internet **remarkably**⁶.

If you want to follow your friends on Facebook or download the latest games, a device^{*} which can go online is **required**⁷. Tablets can **connect**⁸ to the Internet using Wi-Fi^{*} or a wireless data service^{*}. Even if you're on a **crowded**⁹ bus or train, these light devices are convenient and fun.

The iPad is the most **common**¹⁰ tablet used in Taiwan today. However, some users have **complained**¹¹ that, while it's good for entertainment, it's not as useful as a laptop^{*}. Microsoft plans to **compete**¹² with Apple with its new device, the Surface. The Surface can be used like a laptop, but it is the same **weight**¹³ as a tablet.
