Plastic makes our lives easier, but it is also making the planet, animals, and people sick. It’s everywhere. It’s in the ground, air, and water. Every year, over seven billion kilograms of plastic goes into our oceans alone. Because of this, many people want to stop using plastic.



Taiwan is one of a few countries trying to solve the problem. In 2019, the country started by banning some restaurants from giving plastic straws to customers. Now, only people that order food to take home or go to drink shops can get straws. And soon, those places will also have to stop.

Straws are a big source of pollution, and Taiwanese use over three billion plastic straws a year. That is almost half of the eight billion straws polluting beaches today. Lowering the number of straws Taiwanese people use will make a big difference.

Taiwan is not the only place doing this, either. Great Britain, Scotland, and a few US and Canadian cities are also trying to stop people from using plastic straws. Because straws are not necessary, many see it as the perfect place to start.
