Everyone has something in common². We all have to deal with difficult³ people. It's never easy. If you take a few tips⁴ from the animal kingdom⁵, though, it can be a little bit easier. When you face⁶ a difficult person, think of a big angry⁷ elephant coming toward⁸ you. What should you do? Move out of the way, of course! Just let the elephant pass⁹ by. Similarly¹⁰, when negative¹¹ people are around¹² you, don't try to fight¹³ or argue¹⁴ with them.

Difficult people can also be like bees. They fly around because they want you to fight with them. Stay calm¹⁵ around them. Be ready for anything they might do. Sometimes, you can't avoid¹⁶ a difficult person. So, be an eagle¹⁷. Fly high above¹⁸ them. When you see them from far¹⁹ away, you'll understand²⁰ them better. Or, you can be a hyena²¹. Hyenas laugh²² at everything. Find the humor²³ in a difficult situation²⁴ and make a joke. People can't be mad if they're laughing.
