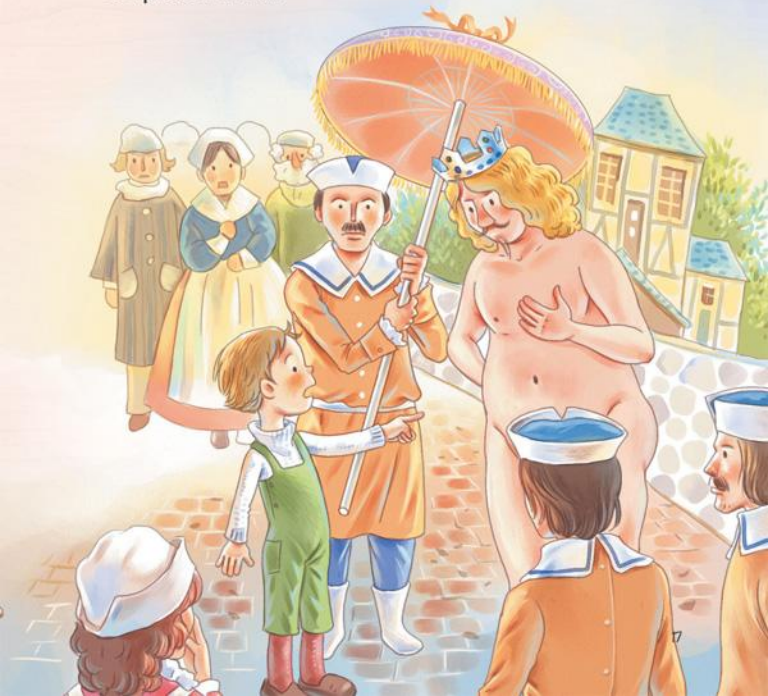

clothes vs. cloth 的差別

clothes [kloz]	cloth [klɒθ]
複數名詞。泛指所有的衣物，包括外套、褲子、裙子等。	① 物質名詞作單數用，指製作衣服的布、布料。 ② 可數名詞，指抹布等作為特定用途的布，複數形為 cloths [kloʊθz]。

- ④ Becky wears the nicest clothes.
貝琪穿著最好的衣服。
- ④ I used blue cloth to make my dress.
我用藍色的布來做我的洋裝。

sb gets excited about sth 某人對某事感到興奮

解 形容詞 excited [ɪk'saɪtɪd] 在此是指「興奮的」，主詞為「人」。

- ④ Frank is getting excited about the coming holidays.
法蘭克對即將到來的假期感到興奮不已。

若以事物當主詞則要用動詞 excite，句型為 sth excites sb，意為「某事物使某人興奮、高興起來」。

- ④ Talking about traveling always excites my father.
討論旅遊的事情一向讓我父親很興奮。

sb admits sth 某人承認某事

解 動詞 admit [əd'mɪt]（承認）之後可直接接名詞、V-ing 或 that 子句，也可以接 to + N./V-ing。動詞三態為 admit-admitted-admitted。

- ④ Martin admitted that he made a mistake.
馬丁承認他犯了錯。
- ④ The boy admitted to stealing the money.
那個男孩承認他偷了錢。

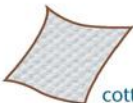

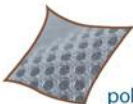
