There are also four new stops on this route: West Point, Green Garden, Grape Village, and East Beach. If you **board**⁴ at any of those stops this month, your trip is free.

We are also **improving**⁵ our bus stops, so some will be closed for **repairs**.⁶ Starting at 10 a.m. on Saturdays, there will be no **service**⁷ at River Street, Forest Hill, Third Street, or City University. A free shuttle* will take passengers from City Center and **drop them off** near those **areas**.⁸ Service will return to those stops at 10 6 a.m. each Monday.

Our new Circle Route also opens in June. It's perfect for weekend travel! A Circle Route ticket will let you travel the route all day long. On race days, buses will also stop at the race course.* After a race, ride to the city zoo and see the baby lions. Then, go to Old Town for some delicious snacks.

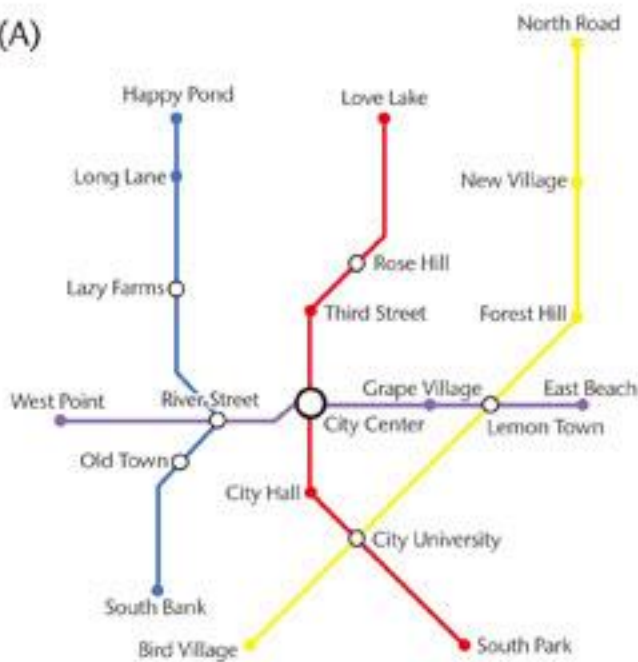

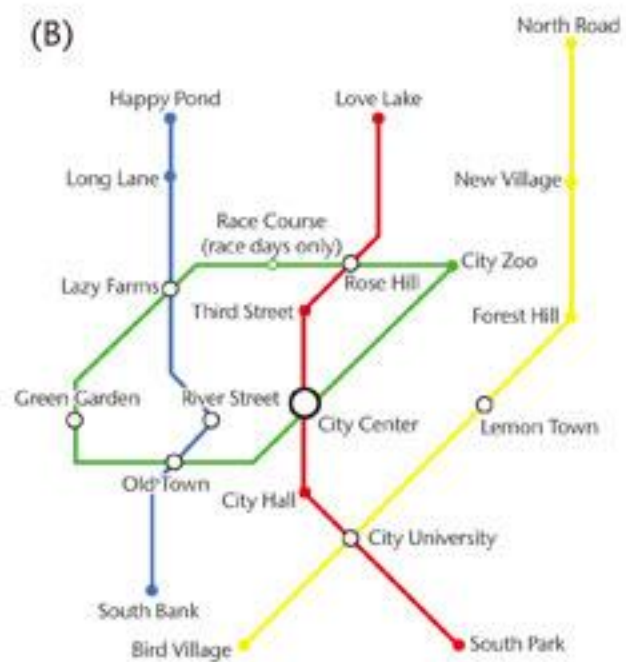

What did Central Bus Company's bus routes probably look like before June 1?

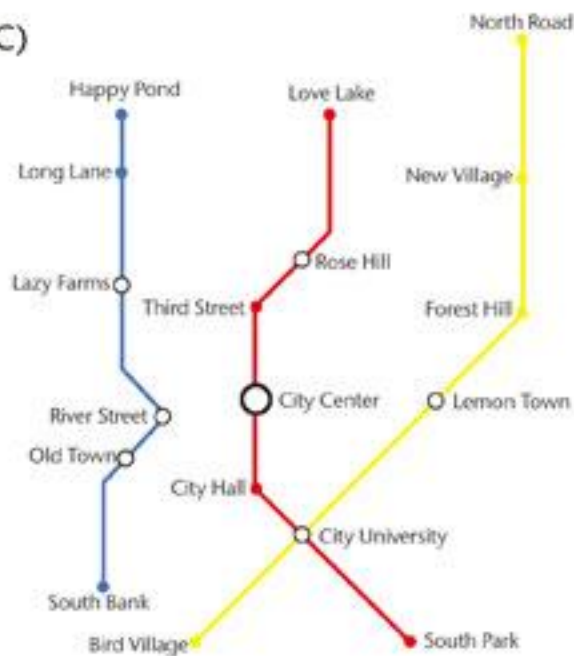
