


One day, the **hare**¹ told some other animals that he could run fast. He said, “I have never lost a race. I will **race**² anyone.”

解 **out of** 這個片語的意思「在……的範圍外」，**sight** 表「視野」，**out of sight** 即是「在視線範圍外；遠離視線」，也就是「看不見」的意思。

④ I watched the car until it drove out of sight.


